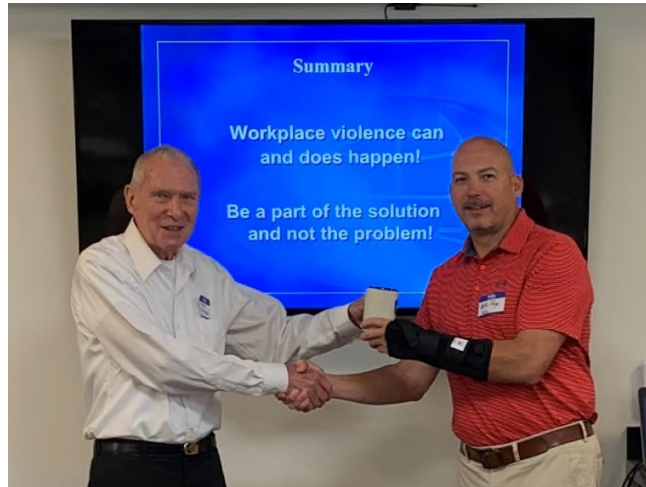
Community Outreach
